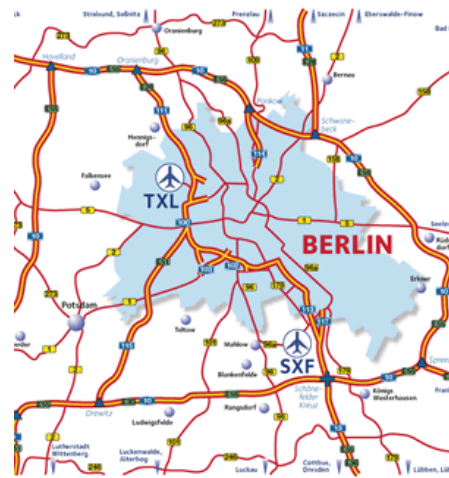

From Berlin-Tegel airport take the bus TXL (direction “Unter den Linden/Friedrichstr.”) to “Unter den Linden” (about 30 min.), change there to Bus 100/200 in direction “Zoologischer Garten” (about 15 min). Take the exit “Nordische Botschaften/ Adenauer Stiftung”.



By air: Berlin-Schönefeld
